Stephen C. Daly serves as the Deputy Director, Operational Test and Evaluation (DOT&E) for Land and Expeditionary Warfare. He is directly responsible for assessing the adequacy of operational and live fire test and evaluation for land and expeditionary warfare systems within the Department of Defense. Mr. Daly is responsible for timely, accurate, and independent reporting to the Secretary of Defense and Congressional Defense Committees on demonstrated performance, mission accomplishment, operational effectiveness, operational suitability, lethality, and survivability of major weapon systems.

Mr. Daly served DOT&E as an Army colonel from 1994 to 1999, first as Military Assistant for Tactical Land Warfare and then as Senior Military Assistant to the Director. Mr. Daly served as a research staff member at the Institute for Defense Analyses supporting DOT&E. He was selected as member of the Senior Executive Service and appointed to his current position in 2000.

Mr. Daly served for twenty-seven years as an Army Field Artillery officer in various command and staff positions in 1st Armored Division, III Corps, V Corps, VII Corps, the U.S. Military Academy, Deputy Chief of Operations and Plans on the Army Staff, and Director, Operational Test and Evaluation.

Mr. Daly received a Master of Science in National Resource Strategy from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, a Master of Science in Geodetic Science/Analytical Photogrammetry from The Ohio State University, and a Bachelor of Science from the U.S. Military Academy at West Point.
