Colonel Verde received his commission as a Signal Officer from Ohio University in 1997. He is a graduate of the Signal Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, The Maneuver Captain Career Course, Combined Arms and Services Staff School, Command and General Staff College, and the United States Army War College.

COL Verde is currently performing the duties of (PTDO) Deputy Director in the Office of the Secretary of War, Operational Test and Evaluation. Prior to the War College he was assigned to Headquarters, Department of the Army G8, where he served as the Military Director for the Army Modeling and Simulation Office. His command assignments include 3 months as Commander of B Company, and 34 months as Commander of C Company, 1st Battalion, 148th Infantry Regiment, Tiffin Ohio where he deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
