



CVN78 Showed OT&E Costs at **0.4%** of Program Acquisition Costs



Review of 76 Programs


- Service Operational Test Agencies (OTAs) and IDA reviewed OT&E costs of 76 programs
- Average marginal OT&E cost was 0.654%.



Cost of OT&E as Percent of Program Acquisition Cost


OT&E is usually $1\% \pm 0.5\%$ of Program Acquisition Cost

Sources of Variability



- Low Program Acquisition Cost (PAC) is dominant source of high relative OT&E cost
- Program type is important. Generally, OT&E costs for development > modification > follow-on test
- Expense of expendable test articles and range costs are third major driver

An Old "Tail" of *De Minimis*T&E Costs




This slide was used in early 90s to put the cost of LFT&E testing on the C-17 into the context of fleet procurement.

LFT&E cost equaled cost of procurement of one plane's tail

Test and Evaluation Costs over Time





- T&E Costs are proportionally heavy at the end of program life
- There are multiple T&E budget lines
 - Contractor testing, Government DT, OT, LF
 - VV&A, Certifications, Interoperability
